Extending an Interest in Dragons with Clay - February 19th, 2016 One of the most intriguing books from our library bus trip earlier this month is "The Boy Who Painted Dragons" by Demi. After reading it several times, teachers noticed an increase in dragons as a theme in children's dramatic play, stories, & art. In attempt to extend their thinking on the subject, Kalei offered the children clay. Hank, Landon, & Kahlan took Kalei up on her challenge: "Can

we build a dragon?" This is the first time this year a small group has (1) worked together on a clay sculpture, & (2) made a concerted effort to use clay representationally.
