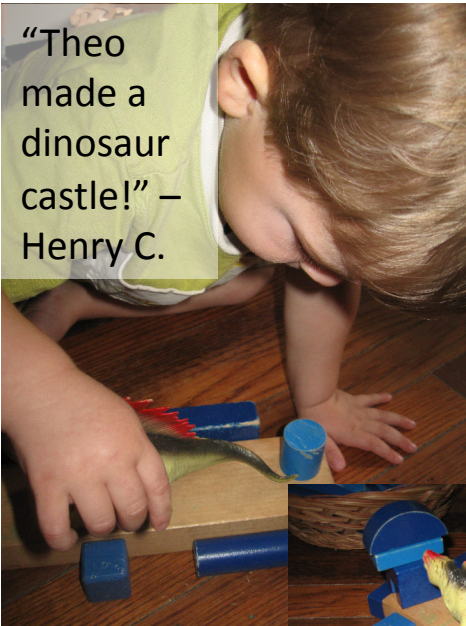


“Theo made a dinosaur castle!” – Henry C.
