

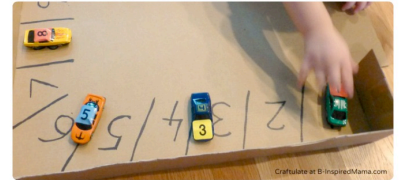
# Hummingbird Herald
