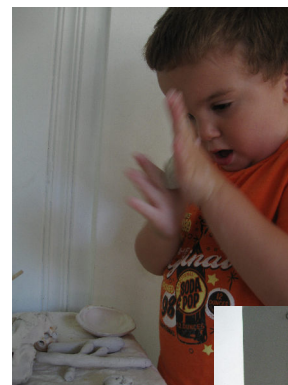


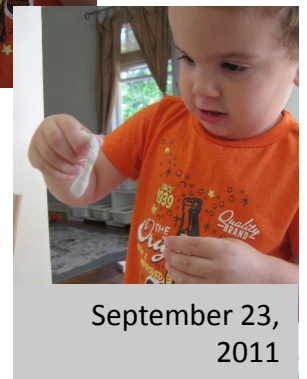
Our ongoing experiences with clay...
