

Tracing Alphabet Magnets - June 19th, 2016

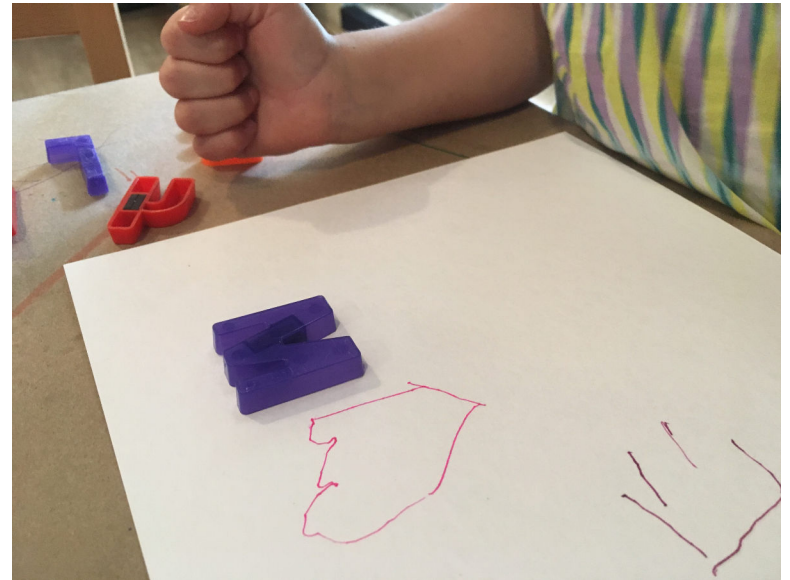
