

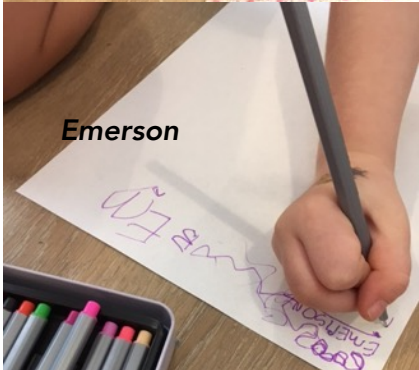

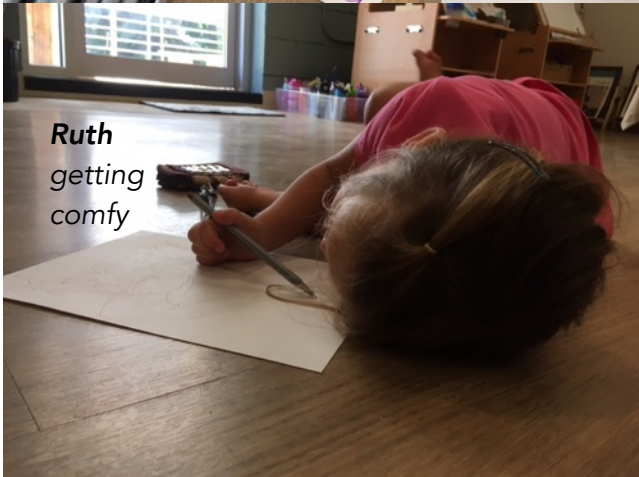
Later, a small group worked with our new set of Fineliner pens after a discussion about how we can care for them. Please see the second page for the children's words from the drawing session.

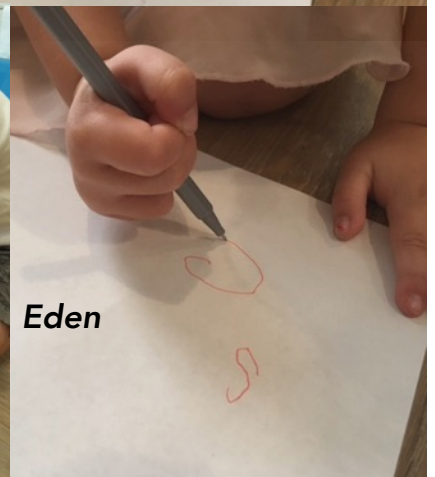
